Edinbane Wind Farm wins green energy gong

Skye wind farm presented with Best Project prize at Scottish Green Energy awards

Vattenfall's Edinbane Wind Farm on the Isle of Skye won Best Project at the prestigious Green Energy Awards last night.

The annual event at the National Museum in Edinburgh is run by Scottish Renewables and was hosted by popular personality Fred MacAulay.

Edinbane Wind Farm, completed in June 2010, has a total installed capacity of 41.4MW and can generate enough power to meet the annual equivalent electricity demand of 22,000 households.

Vattenfall's Ross Cant, Site Manager for Edinbane, said on news of the win: "Winning a Green Energy Award is fantastic news for the wind farm. This does not just recognise the efforts of our construction and operations team but also the communities in Edinbane and Struan who have supported this project since its inception more than a decade ago. Even at this early stage Edinbane is a success story, and one which I hope can be used as an example of good practise elsewhere in the industry."
